Encore Club 2021-2022

The Encore Club is the parent booster club of the San Clemente High School Dance Team that assists in funding and volunteer support to the Team, its Director, Advisor and Coaches.

Parents and families contribute their time and talent to help raise funds for the team, work with the Director and Coaches to provide volunteer support throughout the year, and provide manpower for team events.

Encore Club does NOT make decisions on choreography, costumes, performances, competitions or any other elements of curriculum. The role of parents and family members is to be helpful behind the scenes and support decisions of the Coaches and Director.

MONTHLY MEETINGS

Parents are encouraged to attend monthly meetings to hear from our Director and Coaches about calendar updates and program information and other Encore Club members regarding fundraising and volunteer support needs. The President, Coaches and Director make every effort to keep the meetings brief and informative.

Encore Club meets on the 2nd Tuesday of the month year-round, unless otherwise specified.

PARENT VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

The Encore Club has Board positions, along with a number of opportunities that are designed to suit the many talents of our families. One parent of each dancer is recommended to commit to a position for the year. In addition, families participate in all events by providing manpower and/or donated goods. We are a small organization and one of the keys to our success is strong parent participation.

COSTUMES

Costumes purchased for competition or concerts are property of the Dance Team unless otherwise specified. Costumes owned by the team will be returned by the dancer. In most cases, costumes to be kept by the team will be paid by the Encore Club. In cases where costumes are to be kept by the dancer, the dancer will be asked to pay.

CONCERTS

The Dance Team will produce two concerts: Winter 2021 and Spring 2022. Attendance is mandatory both nights of Spring Concert for all dancers. Parents are encouraged to volunteer in a support function.

OTHER EVENTS

The Dance Team participates in many on-campus events over the course of the

school year, including Spirit Assemblies, Football Games, 8th Grade Expo, Basketball Games, and Homecoming. We have also been invited to participate in community events such as the Sheriff's Red Ribbon Parade, Hunger Walk, Character Counts, and Relay for Life. Parent volunteers may be needed to provide transportation to these events, and are always welcome as fans.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The Dance Team is a year-round commitment on the part of the dancer. Your family's enthusiastic commitment to the Encore Club is what makes it possible to provide such an elite program for our dancers.

Family Fundraising & Target Dates

In order to maintain the current standards and level of accomplishment of the Dance Team, annual and monthly Fundraising Drives and suggested goals have been established. The Fundraising Drives and goals are established to ensure a steady cash flow to the program to cover cost of choreography, coaching, costuming, competition entry fees, and concert expenses.

FAMILY FUNDRAISING

Opportunities are available to help each dance team family raise money to achieve its donation goal for the season. Fundraisers currently include: Concert program ad sales and letter writing/ direct donations. Direct donations from participant families are always welcome as well.

Events or fundraisers may be added or dropped, as determined by the budget. To provide the same quality program as we currently have, the goal is to have each family donate/fundraise \$4200 for 2021-2022.

Mandatory team activities are covered by Family Fundraising and Team Fundraising. Optional activities will be charged on an activity by activity basis as needed to cover costs. *Note that donations cannot be required for participation in the Dance Team.*

TIMING OF FAMILY FUNDRAISING

Like many sports, our program cash demands are heaviest at the beginning of the season and are needed for choreography, costuming, competition entry fees and related expenses to get our season off to a strong start. Therefore, we request that each family donate or fundraise as much as they can as early as possible. Please reach out to Encore President, Suzi Cooks or Treasurer, Todd French if you have any questions or need help with fundraising. We realize that each family is different. Accordingly, attached is an example of the various ways each family might accomplish its fundraising goals. See attached worksheet entitled *Annual Fundraising Examples*

Individual Dance Team Family Suggested Monthly Goal per Fundraising Drive: May 2021 through February 2022 -\$420 per month

Monthly Fundraising Drive Target Dates (dates correspond with monthly Encore Club Meetings which are the 2nd Tuesday of every month).

Each dance team family may use a combination of upfront and monthly donations and fundraising to achieve its annual donation/ fundraising goal. See attached worksheet entitled *Annual Fundraising Examples*.

TEAM FUNDRAISING

In addition to Family Fundraising, the Team is supported by Team Fundraisers. Dancers are expected to participate in team fundraising programs including dance clinics, workshops, Clothing for a Cause collections, flocking, rummage sales, product sales, summer and winter boutiques, and other events sponsored by the Encore Club. Proceeds from Team Fundraisers go to the team program as a whole and do not count towards an individual dance team family's fundraising goal.

SENIOR CONCERT PROJECT

Seniors will be given the opportunity to perform a senior project, at the spring dance concert, as decided upon by the Coaches. As this is an optional program, all expenses relating to the senior project (choreography, music, rehearsal time, costuming) will be donated by the senior's family.

SOLOIST OPPORTUNITIES

Competition soloists will be given the opportunity to audition for a solo for the competition season. They will perform a 2 minute or less solo along with having an interview with the Coaches. Soloists will then be selected by the coaches based on exceptional technical ability, and character. As this is an optional program, all targeted fundraising/donations must be current and all expenses relating to the solo (choreography, music, rehearsal time, costuming, and competition entry fees) will be donated by the soloist's family.

USA ELITE DANCE CAMP— The United Spirit Association (the organization under which we compete) This is optional but highly encouraged, approximately \$480 per dancer is needed to cover registration, camp instruction, transportation, lodging, and food.

CAMP GLENDALE — This is optional but highly encouraged, approximately \$155 per dancer including lunch.

A LA CARTE ITEMS: SPIRIT WEAR, TRANSPORTATION, BANQUET, MEMORY BOOK- Costs are to be determined and must be donated by each dance family separately. See Spirit Wear order form for Spirit Wear ordering information. Other items will be communicated to the team as they become available.

MASTER CLASSES—guest artists will be invited to hold a Master Class for the Team and other dancers in the community. Donation is typically \$25 to \$35 per Master Class depending on the guest instruction.

Dance Team Tryout Checklist

The tryout process consists of the timely completion of all required paperwork, 10 minute Interview with every dancer trying out with Coach and Director, two days of instruction, and a performance audition.

I. **First Day of Try-Outs-** SCHS Dance Room- Check in begins at 3:15pm.

Complete and return these items on April 26th, 2021:

- ___ Dance Team Application
- ___ Dance Team Code of Conduct
- ___ Current Unofficial Transcript (get form Academic Advisor at school)
- ___ Current Semester Progress Report (Print from School Loop within 3 days of interview. Academic GPA must be at least 2.0)
- ___ Media Usage & Release
- ___ Athletic Packet/Physical Examination Clearance (see information on physicals below)
- ___ SCHS Dance Team Candidate Interview Questionnaire

II. **Letters of Recommendation** - Due Day 1 of Try-Outs

All dancers are required to provide 2 letters of recommendation; 1 from an Academic teacher and 1 from a Dance teacher. These can be submitted one of three ways. The letters can be submitted on the day of the audition attached to your Dance Team Application, each envelope needs to be sealed and signed by the teacher. The envelopes can also be submitted by your teacher to Laura Flynn's mailbox in the SCHS Administrative Office or via mail, 700 Avenida Pico, San Clemente, 92673. Please provide your teacher with an envelope and appropriate postage if needed. The last option is for the teacher to email and a signed pdf to sanclementehsdanceteam@gmail.com by the deadline. Confirm with all teachers a few days before the deadline that they have completed, submitted, and/or sent the evaluation. Recommendations should reference dancer's: attendance, work ethic, commitment, attitude and demeanor in class, and teamwork.

III. **Physical Examination/Clearance** -Due Day 1 of Try-Outs

All dancers are required to provide health history and receive medical clearance to participate in the Dance Team. You may schedule an appointment with your family doctor, Dr. Cullen (contact information provided) or take advantage of the SCHS Athletic Department physicals (if offered prior to interviews) to get clearance.

Dance Team Code of Conduct

It is essential that both dancers and parents review the responsibilities of becoming a member of the San Clemente High School Dance Team. The dedication and time commitment obligations are substantial. This document clarifies expectations and outlines rules and consequences. The items listed in this contract are applied uniformly to all dancers. They are in place to ensure dancer safety, consistency of the team, and appearance for community performances/events, competitions, and concerts.

As a member of the SCHS Dance Team, I acknowledge and agree to:

- a. Maintain a positive attitude at all times.
- b. Be respectful toward the Director, Coaches, Advisor, Parents, and fellow team members at all times.
- c. Conduct myself in a suitable manner as a member of the SCHS Dance Team at all times, on and off campus, and on social media sites.
- d. Follow directions the first time they are given.
- e. Arrive at all practices, concerts, competitions, and other events on time, in proper attire, and with all supplies needed.
- f. Accept and apply constructive correction.
- g. Wear appropriate SCHS Dance Team attire at all games, events, and specific school days when not in costume.
- h. Remain with the dance team in the stands or other designated areas at games, competitions, and other events unless given permission by the Director or Coaches to do otherwise.

I understand that Dancers must commit a great deal of time throughout the year. Other school activities, social or family plans, and job schedules cannot conflict or interfere with scheduled after school practices, performances, competitions, fundraising, or community service events. This includes but is not limited to school field trips, membership in clubs or taking classes that regularly meet during scheduled rehearsal times, and participation in other sports or performance groups.

Please initial _____ / _____ I understand that I **must** attend the team's Home Camp, **August, 2021**. (Dates will be announced ASAP) Home Camp days/times are tentative based on School Activities.

I understand that I must maintain an academic GPA of 2.0 or higher in order to stay on the team. In addition, I know I must maintain citizenship and work habits of "S" or better. Two consecutive semesters of below a 2.0 academic GPA will disqualify me from the team and render me ineligible to try out for the SCHS Dance Team the following year.

I understand that my attitude, dedication and enthusiasm are just as important as the technical and athletic skills involved in dancing. I will represent my school/team in the best way possible and be a good example to my classmates.

I understand that my social media pages and entries reflect upon the team and are subject to review by the Coaches and Director at any time. Members will conduct themselves in accordance with the rules, expectations and in such a manner that will not hurt or embarrass the SCHS Dance Department at all times, on and off campus, and using social media sites. Evidence presented on the internet using social media such as Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, Snapchat etc. will be considered a violation of this rule. In addition I will not post pictures or video of any competition dances or costumes on social media sites during the competition season, and after that only with the approval of the Coaches and Director.

I understand that I must adhere to the District, school, dance team, practice, performance, competition, and community dress code. No extreme hair styles (no unnatural hair color, no shaved head); hair must be able to be styled in a pulled back low/ high ponytail or bun. No visible tattoos or body piercing (except for ears); consider timing when getting ear piercings as all jewelry must be removed for competitions and concerts.

I understand that Team Spirit Wear is to be worn only by members of the Dance Team. I will not loan items imprinted with SCHS Dance Team to non-team members. I will not wear my Team Spirit Wear in any personal social media videos with inappropriate conduct.

I understand that quitting the team is final. If I am dismissed or decide to quit, there will be no refunds. Choosing to leave the team immediately excludes me from all dance team activities, materials, and events.

Attendance Requirements Please initial /

I understand that the practice schedule changes periodically and that practice hours are flexible, but will include Monday 2:00-7 pm; Tuesday 2:00-5:30 p.m./ & 6:00-8:00 p.m.; Thursday 1:00-3:30 p.m.; and Friday 3:00-6:00 p.m.

I understand that extra practices on evenings and weekends are scheduled prior to competitions and concerts. Dance Team obligations include 3-4 Sunday commitments as needed for choreography, concert and competitions.

Seniors will be excused from a maximum of two (**2**) rehearsals for college visits with prior approval by the Coaches and Director. (30 Days Prior)

Appointments with dentists, chiropractors, doctors, orthodontists, the DMV, work, family vacations or other practices/competitions with other dance studios are not allowable excused absences. Please schedule them on Wednesdays.

AP/IB review sessions and tests, illness with fever or vomiting and death of an immediate family member are the only allowable excused absences.

Dancers with injury are still required to attend rehearsals in order to keep up with changes to choreography.

- a. All practices are mandatory. The practice schedule will be determined at the beginning of the week on Sunday. The Director and Coaches reserve the right to call extra practices as often as needed.
- b. All performances are mandatory. This includes, but is not limited to competitions, concerts, games, school activities, parades, and other community events.
- c. All dancers are required to ride the team bus, or with Coaches and District approved parents to and from all competitions, unless otherwise notified. Teammates are not approved drivers to and from any events.
- d. If the Director or Coaches choose any other activities, the Director and/or Coaches shall determine if the event is mandatory or optional.
- e. Any dancers selected to be an alternate for any competition routine is to remain an alternate for the entirety of the year. See excused absence policy. No other exceptions will be made with regards to missing rehearsals if placed as an alternate. An alternate dancer is vital to the success of any competitive routine in the event of injury, illness, etc.
- f. All competition decisions are made by the Coaches. This includes but is not limited to: choosing competition schedule, dropping routines from competition, changing routine divisions or changing number of dancers in a routine, etc.
- g. No placement in any routine is final. Any dancer can be replaced at any time throughout the season with an alternate dancer if that dancer is not upholding the competitive needs of any competitive routine. This

includes but is not limited to too many missed practices/rehearsals, lack of performance quality, failure to execute choreography, lack of work ethic, etc.

Attendance of Dance Classes at Outside Studios/Participation in Teams with Outside Studios

Participation in classes at outside dance studios is **provided that such attendance does not conflict or interfere with scheduled after school practices, performances, competitions, or fundraising.**

Participation in teams with outside dance studios is discouraged specifically during competition season, due to the risk of overuse and injury. Any participation in outside dance studio teams should be discussed with the Coaching Staff at the beginning of the season.

I understand that my commitments to the SCHS Dance Team are required to come first, and, as such, will take priority over any other outside activity I participate in. Failure to meet Dance Team commitments may result in performance suspensions and/or dismissal from the team.

Consequences for Rule Infractions

I understand that the inability to adhere to this contract is cause for suspension or dismissal from competitions, concerts, or the Dance Team. I understand that I may be removed from a dance if my academic GPA falls below a 2.0 during a semester or if I have an "F" in any academic class. Warnings are not required before enforcing rules. Performance Suspensions will be imposed for:

- a. Disrespect toward the Director, Coaches, Captains, other team members, or other authorities.
- b. Unexcused absence from dance rehearsal, mandatory activities or school.
- c. Excessive absences or tardiness to dance or school.
- d. Failure to cooperate with the Director, Coaches, Captains, other team members, or other authorities.
- e. Inadequate performance, lack of enthusiasm, or any display that could be viewed as substandard.
- f. Failure to abide by team rules and regulations as outlined in this contract.
- g. Academic GPA below 2.0 for one semester.
- h. Suspension from school.

- i. Failure to complete assigned duties.
- j. Failure to eliminate "team times". Dismissal from the Team will be imposed for:
 - a. Accumulation of disciplinary problems.
 - b. 5 unexcused absences from school.
 - c. GPA below 2.0 for two consecutive semesters.
 - d. Conduct unbecoming of a SCHS Dance Team member that reflects negatively on the reputation of the school and team.
 - e. Repeated insubordination toward the Director, Coaches, Captains, or other authorities.
 - f. Any illegal activity, including but not limited to use of tobacco, vaping, drugs, alcohol, etc.

Parent Responsibilities

- a. Parents are encouraged to volunteer and fundraise with the Encore Club (the booster club for the SCHS Dance Team).
- b. Parents understand that the Coaches and Director are responsible for decisions related to all performance, competition, and technical matters.
- c. Parents should maintain open communication with the Director and Coaches at all times and address issues with the Coaches and Director.
- d. Parents are encouraged to attend the Encore Club meetings and be informed about upcoming events and activities.

We have reviewed and discussed this Contract and agree to abide by all the rules, regulations, and expectations of the San Clemente High School Dance Team as set forth in this Contract.
